Individual in Distress

Causing harm to themselves, other(s), or property, call Police at 911

In medical distress or unresponsive, call EMS at 911

Someone experiencing unsheltered homelessness who wants assistance, call London Cares at 519-667-2273 (CARE), available 24/7

Unsheltered Homelessness / Urban Camping

Do not attempt to remove the camp.

Discarded Needles or Drug Using Equipment

If you come across needles found on City Property, call **519-661-2489 ext. 4965**. The phone line is answered 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
